



## **Beginner/Intermediate Drawing**

**Mondays, 6:30-9 pm, and Saturdays, 10:30 am-1 pm**

In this class, students will learn and expand upon basic drawing techniques using pencils, pen, and ink on paper.

The class meets in room 127 on the first floor of the Greensboro Cultural Center. Parking is available in the Church Street Garage (first hour free, 75¢ per hour thereafter) or there is metered street parking nearby. Parking is free after 6 p.m.

### **Supply List:**

- 8.5"x11" sketchbook (no smaller)
- 18"x24" drawing pad of white paper
- A notebook for notes
- Assortment of pens (ball point, ink, Sharpies, etc.)
- Assortment of pencils (does NOT have to be a set of drawing pencils)
- Vine charcoal and compressed charcoal—vine is lighter in weight and compressed is denser and compact—have at least one pack of each
- Kneaded eraser and Pink Pearl eraser
